Let this be a reminder that joy and stillness can coexist.


Moment of reflection

Set aside a quiet moment this week to bring something

a funny candle, a spooky garland or a felted ghost.

Let it sit alongside your slowing rhythm as a gentle reminder:
not all must be serious to be meaningful.


Halloween Garland



Create a festive autumn garland with felt. Halloween will be a great success with this spooky Halloween Garland. Easy & fun to make.

Materials needed:

Wool felt: white, orange, black, and purple
Orange cord
Matching yarn
Stuffing wool



Instructions:

Start with the banners. Use matching thread to secure the letters to the banners. Make sure you put your needle through both pieces of felt, so through the edge of the letter and the banner. Any leftover thread or knots stay at the back of the banners, so you won't see them after finishing the garland. After decorating the 4 banners, get a piece of twine and place the banners on either side of the twine. Secure the banners of the same colour by using a blanket stitch to sew around.

For the ghost you first secure the two eyes. Then place the two pieces of felt on either side of the twine and sew along the edges. The bottom can stay open. To make the pumpkin you first attach the black inside onto the pumpkin with a face. Secure the stem on both pieces of orange felt. Place the pumpkin with the stem on either side of the twine and sew around. Your Halloween Garland is finished!
